

Grayling High School In-School Supervision Rules and Regulations

- 1) Students are to report for ISS at 8:10 a.m. on the day they are assigned.
- 2) Student are to have all study materials for the time they are assigned to ISS.
- 3) Students will be assigned to a seat. They are to remain seated at all times and remain quiet at all times.
- 4) Regular school policies are enforced. Radios, CD's, jackets, hats, candy, pillows, pop, food items, sleeping, etc. are not allowed in ISS.
- 5) Washroom breaks are to be recorded on the daily log. While common sense should prevail, the number of such breaks allowed for each student should not exceed one in the morning and one in the afternoon. Approximately five minutes should be allowed for such breaks. Students abusing the privilege are to have a referral written on them. Students must carry a pass with them for this purpose.
- 6) ***PASSES ARE NOT ISSUED DURING LUNCH HOURS.***
- 7) Students in ISS are to eat lunch between lunch periods.
- 8) Students are expected to be actively working on assignments while in ISS.
- 9) Any student skipping or being sent home from ISS for disciplinary reasons may be given an out-of-school suspension. The student will return to ISS the day he/she returns to school to complete their ISS.
