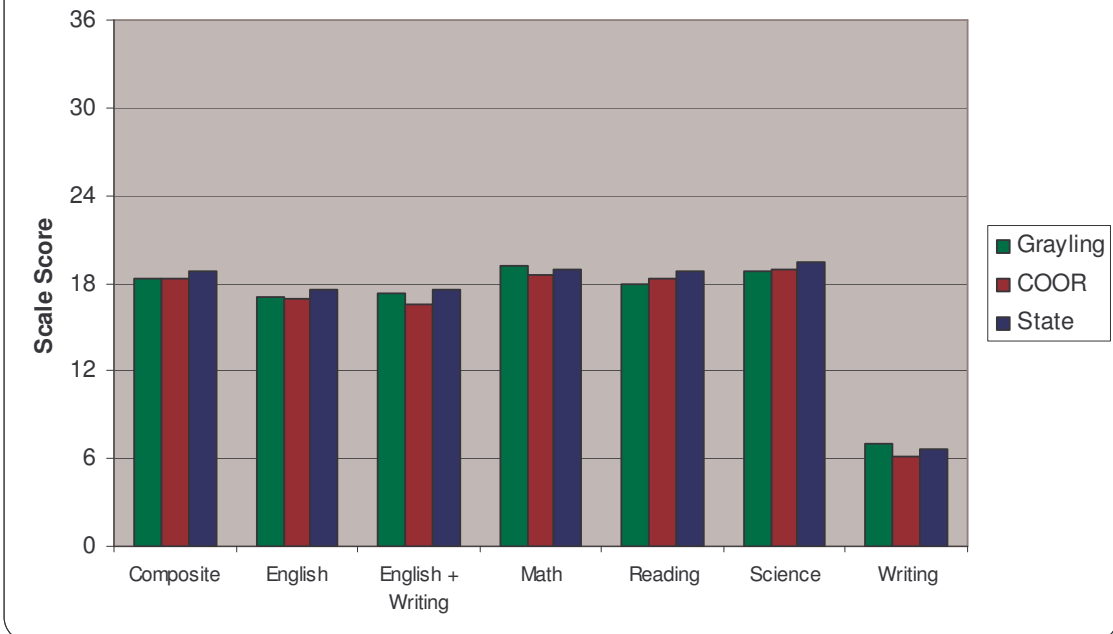
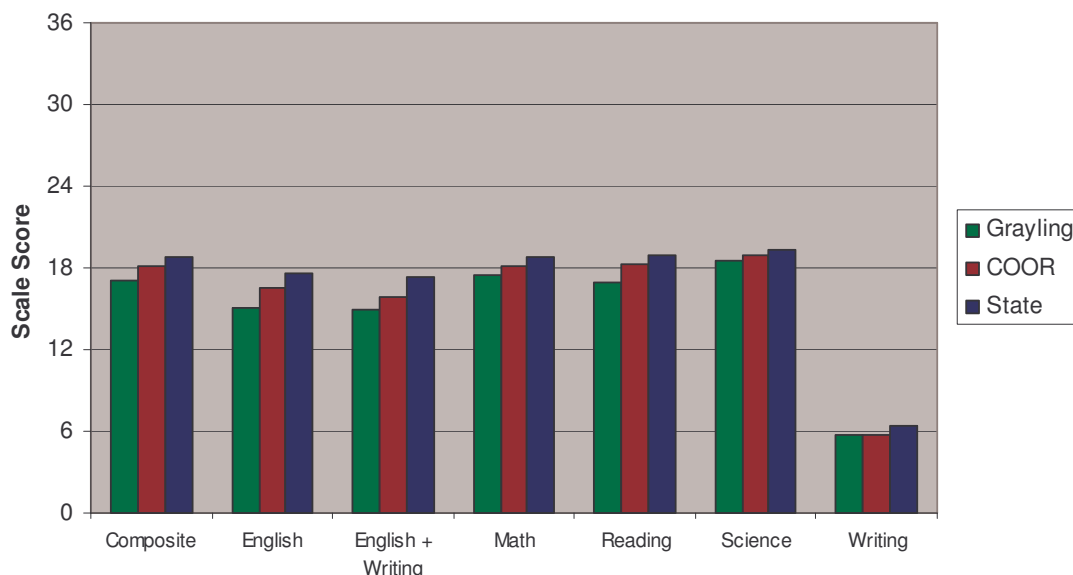

The ACT is a portion of the Michigan Merit Examination which is administered to the junior class in the spring of each year, beginning with the spring of 2007. The MME is used by the State of Michigan to determine the Adequate Yearly Progress as is required under the No Child Left Behind federal law. The MME is a compilation of scores from the ACT, WorkKeys and Michigan generated items.
