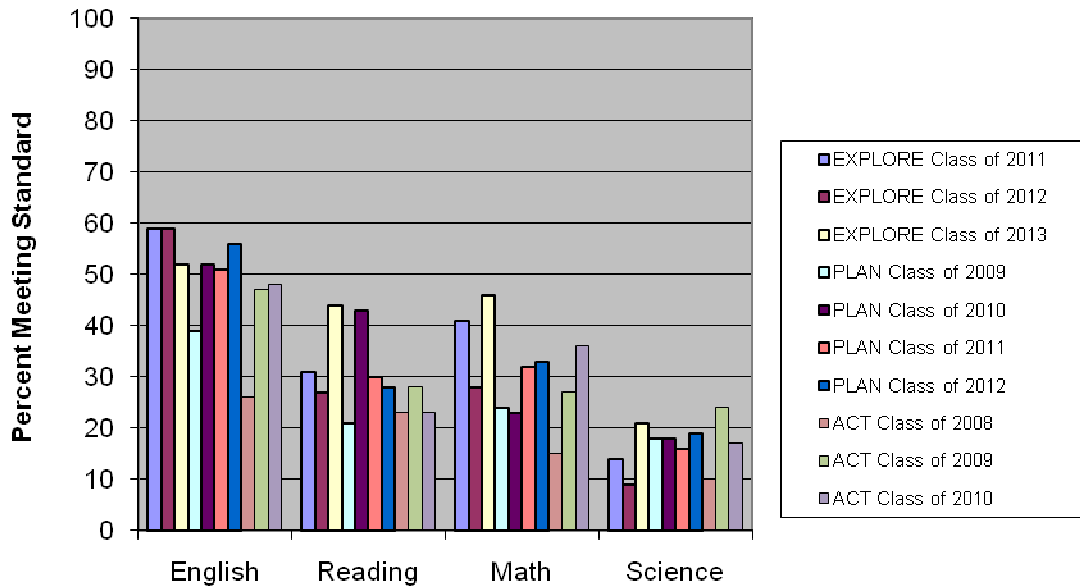

EXPLORE, PLAN and ACT makes up the "EPAS" system of assessments supported by the ACT organization. We use these assessments to monitor progress of the students at Grayling High School and to adjust instruction. EXPLORE is given to all of our freshmen in the fall of each year beginning with the fall of 2007, PLAN is given to all of our sophomores in the fall of each year beginning with the fall of 2006 and the ACT is part of the Michigan Merit Examination required by the federal and state government. The Michigan Merit Examination is administered to the junior class in the spring of each year, beginning with the spring of 2007. The Michigan Merit Examination is used to determine the Adequate Yearly Progress as is required under the No Child Left Behind federal law. The ACT organization has conducted studies to determine what successful college students had scored on their EXPLORE, PLAN and ACT assessments while in high and determined the college readiness standards accordingly.
